I. What are, who are these four beings?

The word "creature": theria - "beast;" zoa - "living ones"

Called beast or creatures that we do not understand!

"2 Eyes" - to see what is happening in all the earth;

"2 Legs" - to quickly move from one location to another

We do not have to speculate as to who these are. The Bible is the best commentary on itself!

III. What They (the creatures) Are Doing:

- (1) First and foremost they are leading in the praise of God!
 - (a) Night and day they do not cease to praise Him.
 - (b) The Attributes of God Holiness, Almighty (power,) Eternal

(Glory, Honor, and Thanks)

* The 24 elders join in the worship - casting their crowns before the throne!
Heavenly Father - Worthy Art Thou
Creator of All Things - For Thy pleasure they are created!

(2) Stand Ready to Execute the Decrees of God (on the earth.)

(Time of Judgment - Decrees of Judgment carried out by Cherubims)
 Why this responsibility?
 One of their own, Lucifer, the anointed cherub, is the one who failed, sinned, and brought sin into God's creation! (Ezekiel 28:14)
 The cherubim will be responsible to enact the judgment of God upon Satan as God reclaims His creation!
