1st Part - 144,000 Jews who will be sealed by God's Spirit - Evangelists to the World

2nd Part - After these things I looked. . .

I. What John Saw -

A great multitude

- (a) From every nation, tribes, people, tongues
- (b) Standing before the throne and before the Lamb
- (c) Clothed in white robes (6:9-11)
- (d) Palm branches were in their hands (servants.)

II. What They Said -

"Salvation to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."

III. What the Angels Did -

Fell on their faces and worshipped God saying,. . . (sandwiched between two Amens)

IV. The Elder's Question and Answer -

- (a) Who are these?

John's reply: "I have no idea."

- (b) Elder - "These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation."

"Washed their robes" (Made white by the blood of the Lamb)

V. What These Redeemed Do -

They serve Him night and day in the temple.
