The Three Categories of Gifts  
(1 Corinthians 12:4-7)

## **Motivational Gifts (v.4)**

Gifts (charisma)

- (1) A motivational gift is the basic inward drive which God places in each Christian to express His love.
- (2) This is the Christian's main gift.
- (3) Every Christian has one and only one motivational gift and it does not change.
- (4) The motivational gifts are listed in Romans 12:4-8.
- (5) There are seven (7) motivational gifts.
- (6) We are called to exercise our gifts.

## **Ministry Gifts (v. 5)**

Ministries (diakonia)

- (1) A ministry gift is the opportunity for Christian service and for each one of us to exercise our motivational gift.
- (2) This opportunity may or may not be a formal ministry position of the church.
- (3) A Christian may have more than one ministry gift. The gift may change.

(4) The ministry gifts are listed in I Corinthians 12:27-31 and Ephesians 4:7-13.

(5) There are 9 ministry gifts listed.

(6) We exercise the motivational gift through our ministry gifts.

## **Manifestation Gifts (v. 6-7)**

Effects (energama)

Manifestation (phanerosis)

- (1) A manifestation gift is the actual result or effect in the lives of those to whom we minister.
- (2) A Christian may receive more than one manifestation gift at a time.
- (3) In a group, the Holy spirit will gift different manifestations to those in the group.
- (4) The manifestation gifts are listed in I Corinthians 12:4-11.
- (5) There are nine (9) manifestation gifts listed.
- (6) As we exercise our motivational gifts through our ministry gifts, the Holy Spirit determines what manifestations will benefit the receiver.
