- I. Political and Governmental Upheavals
  - (1) Wars will be rampant during the Tribulation (6:4)
  - (2) There will be no peace. (6:4)
  - (3) The Antichrist will become dictator over the world and demand allegiance eventually proclaiming himself as god. (13:1-18)
  - (4) Kings of the earth will wage war against God. (16:13-16)
- II. Natural Disasters Beyond Imagination
  - (1) Famine (6:5-6)

    ¼ of World Population Dies
    (2) Pestilence (6:8)
  - (3) Great Earthquake (Mountains & Islands Moved) (6:12)
  - (4) The sea turns into blood. (Everything dies.) (16:3)
  - (5) The Euphrates River dries up. (16:12)
  - (6) Another Great Earthquake (16:18)
  - (7) Huge hailstones come upon men (100 lbs) (16:21)
- III. Chaos in the Heavenlies
  - (1) Sun Black and Moon As Blood (6:12)
  - (2) Meteor Showers (6:13)
  - (3) Hail and Fire Mixed With Blood (1/3 of earth burned) (8:7)

- (4) A great mountain burning with fire is thrown into the sea (1/3 of sea creatures die; 1/3 of ships destroyed) (8:8-9)
- (5) A great star falls from heaven rivers and springs become bitter. (8:10-11)
- (6) One third of sun, moon, and stars are darkened. (8:12)
- (7) The sun scorches men with fire. (16:8)

## IV. Demonic Activity

- (1) Satan's activities are unchecked because the Restraining One is no longer present. (II Thessalonians 2:6-9)
- (2) Demonic insects bring suffering (not death) on all who are without God's seal. (9:3-6)
- (3) Release of the four demons from the Euphrates (They kill 1/3 of mankind with plagues.) (9:13-15)
- (4) Unclean spirits like frogs deceive the kings of the earth and gather them to war against God. (16:14)

## V. Health Issues

- (1) Famine, Pestilence, Plagues, and the Sword (6:8)
- (2) Malignant Sores Upon Man (16:2) (Mark of Beast)
- (3) Scorched with Fire from the Sun (16:8)

## VI. Emotional and Spiritual Results

- (1) All men, great and small, will hide in caves. (6:15)
- (2) Fear and Despair Over the Wrath of God. (6:16)
- (3) Men will seek death and not find it. (9:6)
- (4) Many men will not repent even during persecution. (9:20-21)
